There will be other events occurring on campus at the same time as our event using that parking lot. The lot behind the parking structure is for the **RV campers only.**

SET UP - Friday afternoon between 3 and 7. Please do not arrive earlier than 3pm. Crating is allowed only within the parking structure and there is plenty of room to fit all teams.
